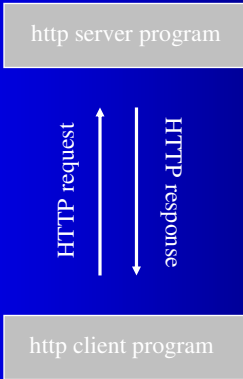

- discussing server giving objects it houses to client
- simple request-response behavior

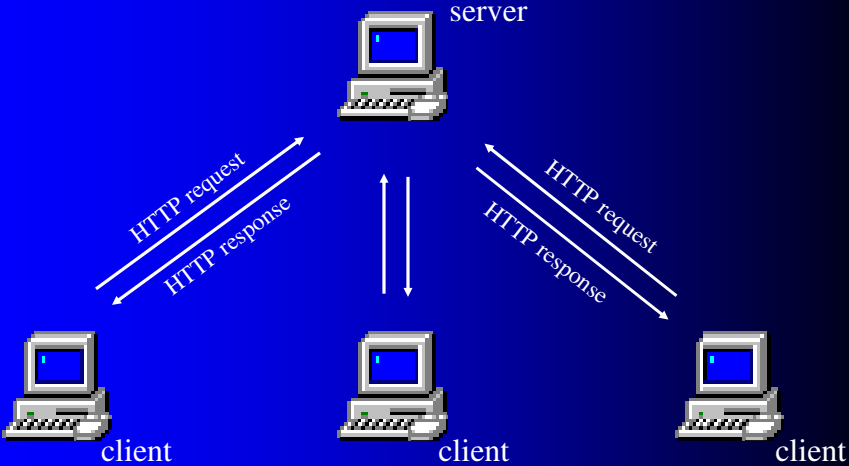

An HTTP conversation



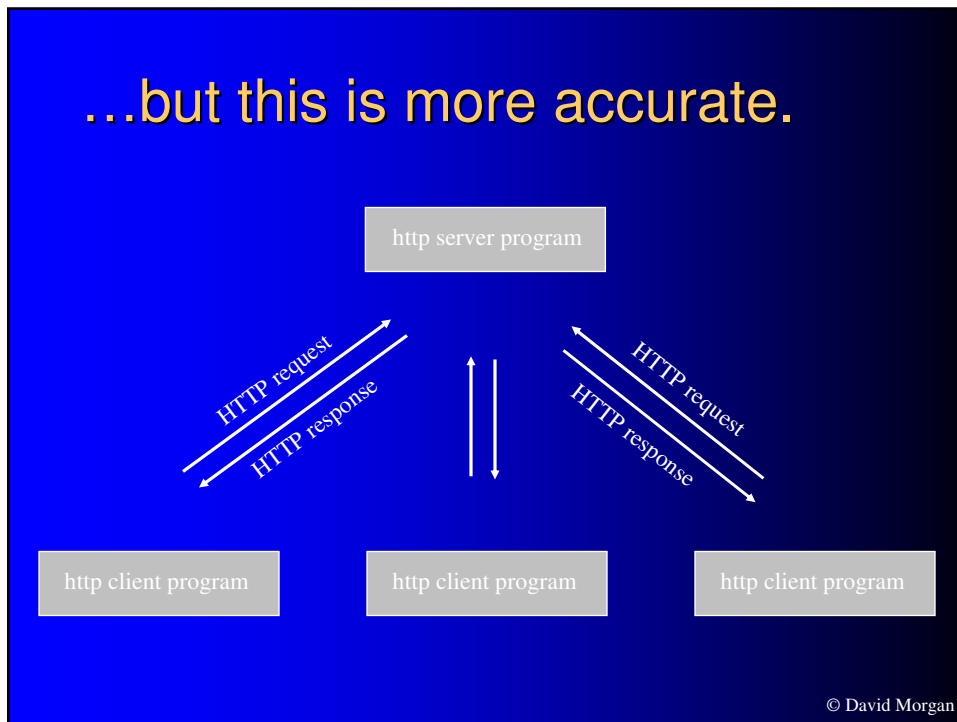

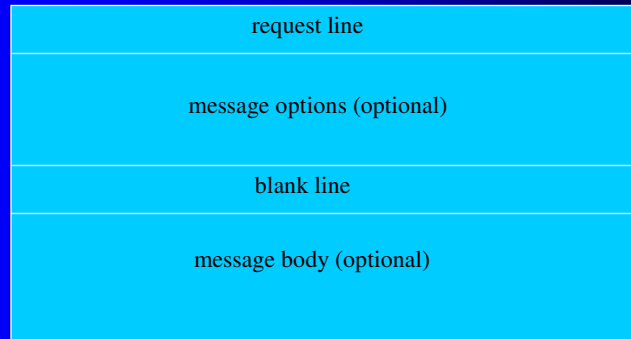

- written in ASCII

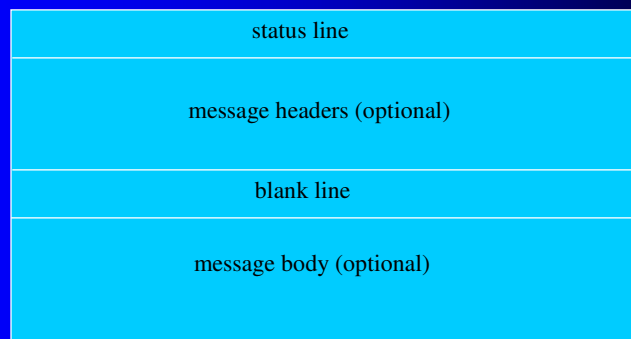
